The program capitalizes on the benefits of participation in the arts as an avenue towards greater academic achievement. *Lasting Impressions* will also inspire a love for ballet and performance, and instill within the students the etiquette, poise and discipline at the core of classical ballet. The initial year of this innovative program will culminate in an end-of-year recital, as well as interaction with professional guest artists and multiple performance-going opportunities for students and their parents.

GEP and CYB have created a unique opportunity to serve the at-risk youth and families of the Charlotte community. These real estate partners look forward to *Lasting Impressions*' contribution to developing the youth within a city that they have been passionately building in for generations.
